The Henderson Police Department conducts one Citizen Police Academy class per calendar year, usually starting in February, with classes on Thursday nights. Seating is limited to 25 students. Preference is given to those students recommended by alumni from previous classes when the class reaches capacity.

Perfect attendance is a nice goal, but not realistic. Do not hesitate to sign up for the Academy because you may have to miss a night. Students are asked not to miss more than three class nights. The classes are one night per week, for ten weeks, lasting three hours per night.

Those who are accepted for the Academy will receive a letter from the department informing them of the date, time and location of the class. Local merchants donate refreshments for each class, usually a deli tray and sodas. The Police Department provides coffee and the break room has vending machines for those who do not like the meat and cheese, vegetable and / or cookie trays provided by the merchants.
