Lineup Instructions

- Please be in line no later than 5:45PM!
- Stakes indicating your entry number will be placed along the curb, starting on South Marshall St. and continuing onto College Ave.
- Your entry number card **MUST** be clearly displayed on the **DRIVERS SIDE** either on the side window, dashboard, or exterior door panel.

Parade Route

- Remember to keep all participants of your entry in your assigned location & controlled.
- Please do not destroy property of the homeowners along the route, and do not block their driveways or vehicles.
- No tossing or handing out anything, including but not limited to candy, beads, or toys!
- Pace your entry in the progression of the parade and always watch for children and other parties while parade is in progress.
- Adults are required to walk alongside units with small children.

Disbanding

- The parade will end on South Marshall St., please go as far down as possible before disbanding.
- If your entry has any participants on the outside of the vehicle (truck bed, trailer, etc.) your entry will need to complete the parade route back where lineup began before disbanding.

Judging

- The Judge's Booth will be in front of the Rusk County Library on East Main St.

Weather

- In the event of inclement weather, a decision will be made by 9:00AM on the day of the parade.
- You will be notified by phone of any changes.
